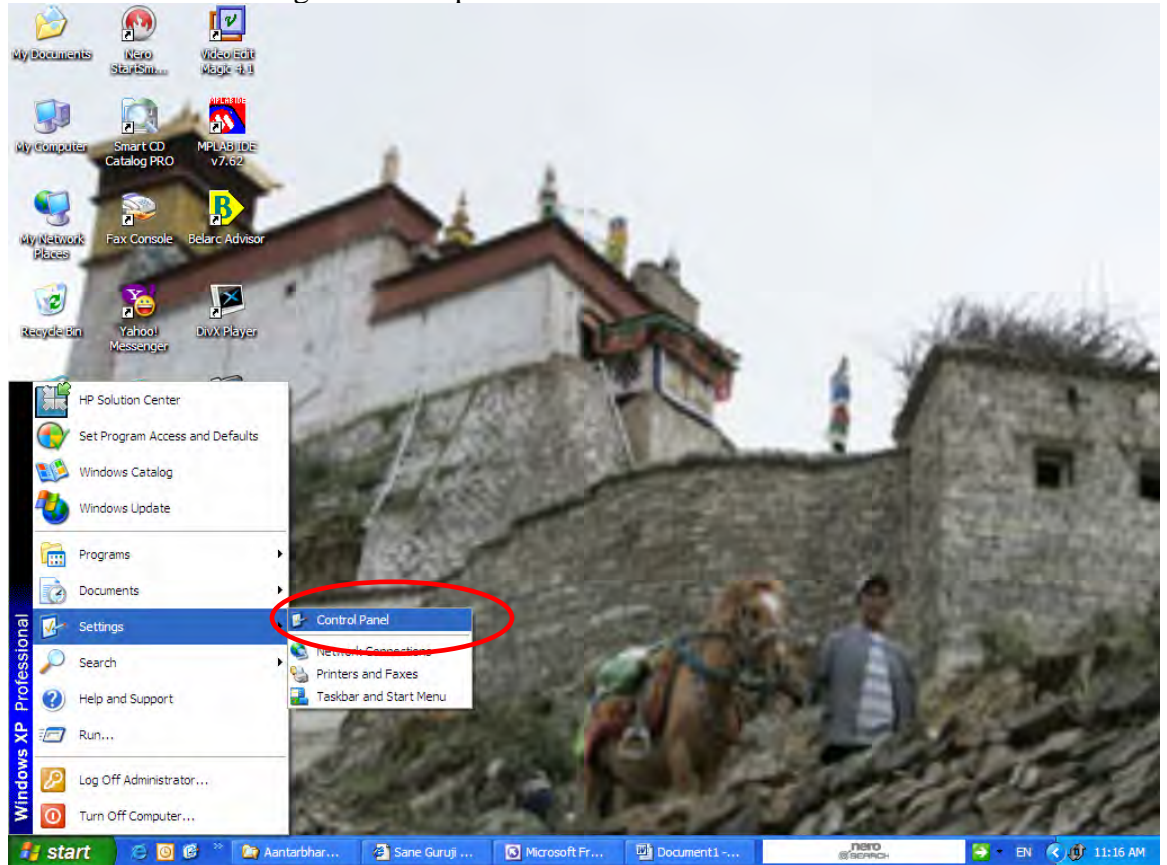


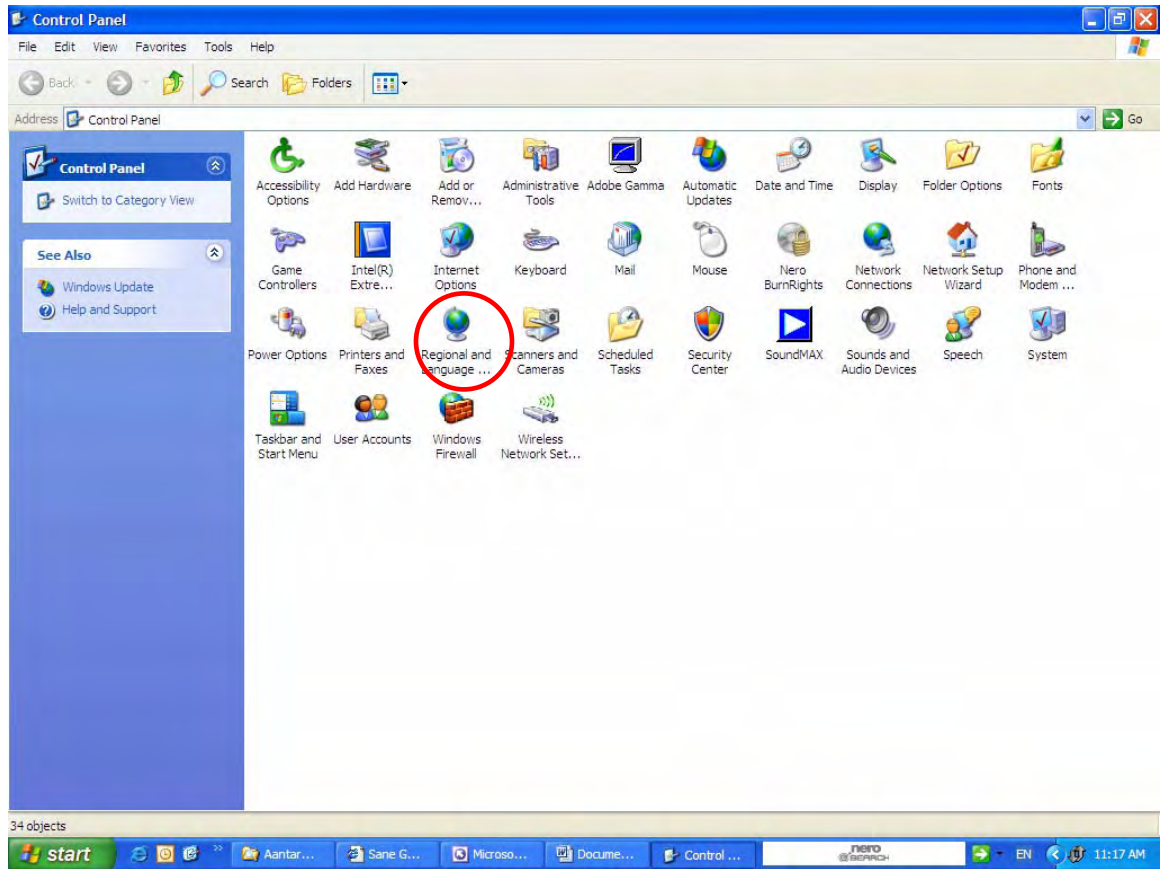
Instruction to install 'Inscript' on windows-XP

1. Step 1:

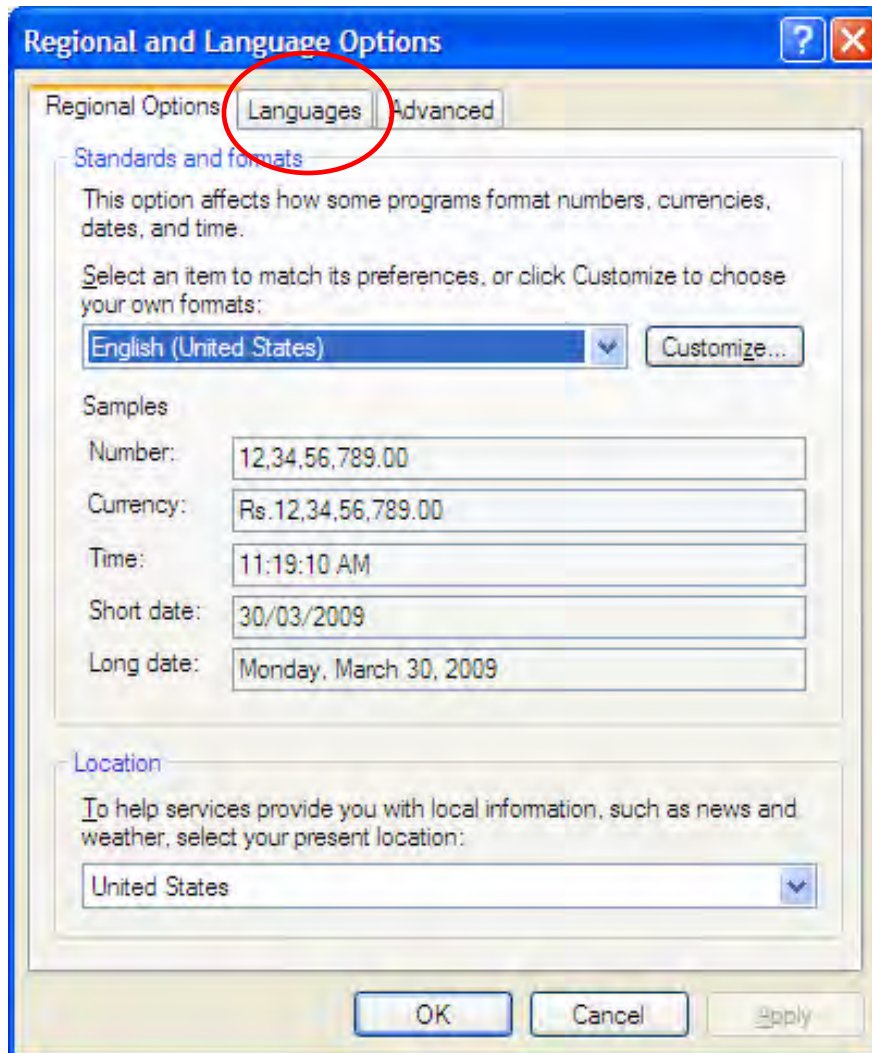
Press START > Settings > control panel



Select 'Regional languages'
(You may need to 'classic view' at left-top of the screen to get the view)



Select languages



-If 'install files for complex scripts' box is already checked, go directly to step 2

-Check on 'install files for complex scripts' (if already not checked) & press apply. You may need to insert windows XP CD –

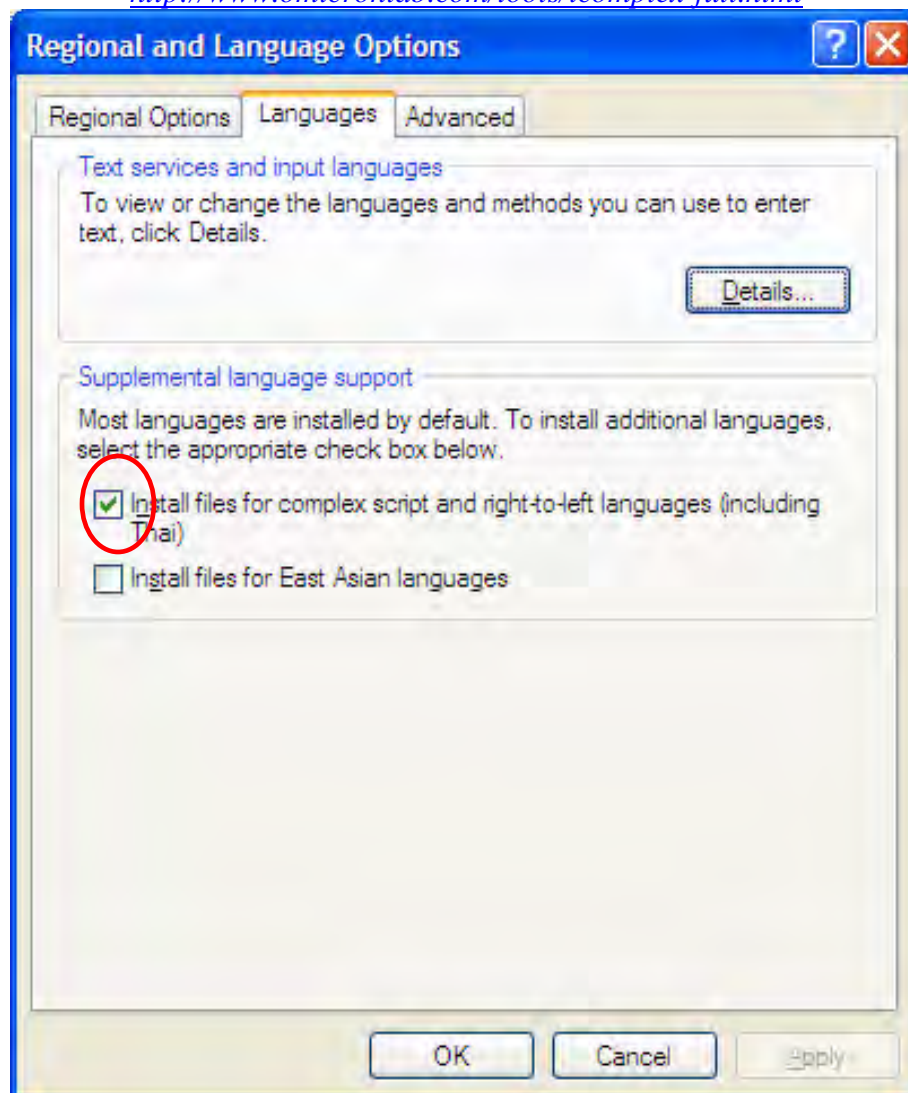

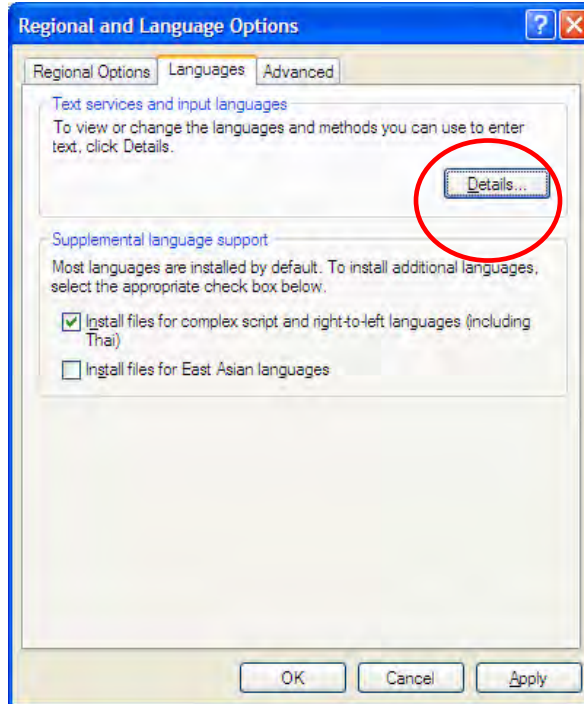

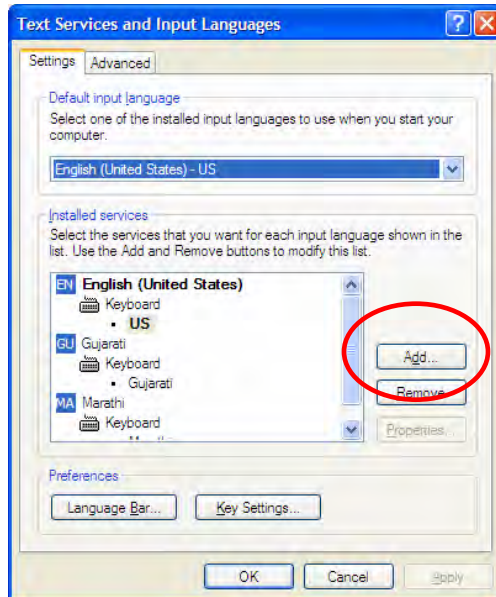
Restart the computer & perform the same steps as above.

Step 2:

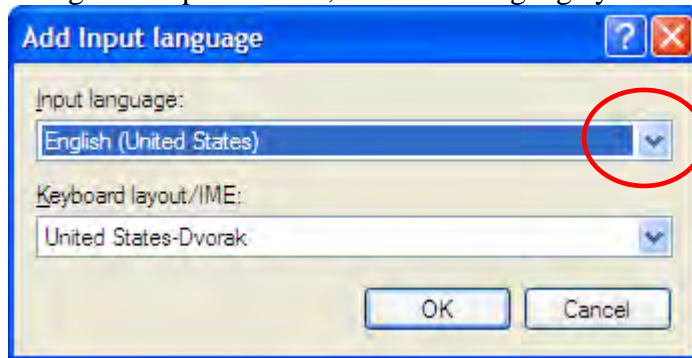
Press details Tab



Press 'ADD'



Using the drop-down list, select the language you need to add.



Press OK.
